# Tasmanian Devil

- Tasmanian Devils are Australia's largest living carnivorous marsupial.
- Their fur is mostly black, with white markings on their bottom and chest.
- The Tasmanian Devil has a very strong jaw, muscly body and a large, broad head.
- Their short, thick tail is also used to store fat for times when food is hard to find.
- They are scavengers, eating carcasses and rarely hunt live prey.
- Tasmanian Devils earned their name for their screams/vocalisations, often heard at night.
