Program details

Kids Club sessions run 4-5pm every Tuesday and Wednesday of the school term. Kids Club meets at the Ticket Office, and then journey out into the park for an adventure. Children engage in hands on nature play, animal experience, familiarising with native bushland, physical activity, arts, stem activities, and social skill building.

After the program finishes, all children must be collected from the Ticket Office. Children are not permitted to leave without a parent or guardian. Children may not meet parents in the carpark, and guardians must be listed on registration forms for collection of children. Strict release policies will be followed to ensure the safety of your children.

Participants require enclosed shoes and long pants, a drink bottle and hat in hot weather, and a rain jacket in cold weather.

Children are welcome to bring a notebook, binoculars, or outdoor equipment relating to the program. We request children do not bring bags, phones or cameras.

Kids Club term fee does not include entry into the park.

We recommend purchasing a Cleland Wildlife Park Membership for free entry for 12 months.

Booking Conditions

- Payment must be made in full at the Cleland Wildlife Park ticket office or over the phone, before the program commences.
- Bookings are not confirmed until payment and all required paperwork is received.
- Kids Club fees do not include entry into park. Park entry must be purchased prior to each session, or current Cleland Membership held.
- Missed Kids Club sessions can be credited towards the following term's fees upon request before the missed session occurs.
- Children are to attend Kids Club independent of parent/guardian, and may not have siblings or friends accompany who are not enrolled in the program.
- The Children's Program Coordinator will give instructions throughout the session that must be adhered to by all participants for health and safety reasons.
- Children may not leave Cleland Wildlife Park after each Kids Club session unless an approved parent/guardian signs them out with the Program Coordinator. Children may not meet parent/guardian in the carpark.
- In the case of extreme or catastrophic fire danger days no Kids Club session will be held. Contact will be made by phone call by 5pm the day before. In this case the missed session may be credited to the following term's membership.
